Full Dress Uniform: Must be worn on Day 5 of calendar  
Must be worn on Special Event Days  
Can be worn on other days of the week if desired

Regular Uniform: Can be worn each day of the week except Day 5

### Boys- Full Dress Uniform

Black dress pants (**Top Marks only**)  
White dress shirt (**Top Marks only**)  
Crested Burgundy vest (Gr. 7-10) (**Top Marks only**)  
Black tie – (Gr. 10 - 12 only) (**Top Marks only**)  
Tartan tie – (Gr. 7 – 9) (**Top Marks only**)  
Black dress shoes and black dress socks  
Burgundy Heritage Blazer – Gr. 11-12 only (**OPTIONAL**)

### Girls- Full Dress Uniform

Tartan Kilt-(**Top Marks only**) (Gr. 10-12) (length- 2 inches above the knee or longer)  
White dress shirt (**Top Marks only**)  
Tartan Skort-(**Top Marks only**) (Gr. 7-9) **All Grade 7 - 9 girls must wear the skort.**  
Crested Burgundy vest (Gr. 7-12) (**MANDATORY**) (**Top Marks only**)  
Black tie – (Gr. 10 - 12 only) (**Top Marks only**)  
Tartan tie – (Gr. 7 – 9) (**Top Marks only**)  
Black dress shoes and black dress knee-high socks or solid black tights  
Burgundy Heritage Blazer – (Gr. 11 & 12) (**OPTIONAL**)

### Regular Uniform and Optional Items

- Black dress pants– (**Top Marks only**)
- Black casual shoes and black socks. Must be all black, no coloured stitching, coloured logos, etc. (**No running shoes or ‘skater’ shoes**)
- Heritage Long/Short Sleeve Polo Shirt- white and/or burgundy (**Top Marks only**)
- Zip Front Micro Polar Jacket (**Top Marks only**), Zip Front Hoodie (**Top Marks only**) or approved HawksWear Athletic Jacket (to be worn over the Polo shirts)
- Black walking shorts - (**Top Marks only**)
- Ladies Black Skirt gr. 10-12 (**Top Marks only**) – must be worn with skin-toned or black stockings or tights or black knee-high socks
- Ladies Biker Short (to be worn under kilt/skirt – cannot show below bottom of skirt)

**When the airport temperature at 7:00 a.m. is –20 degrees Celsius or colder girls may wear their black pants in place of their kilts.  
The rest of the uniform must remain the same.**

**When summer temperatures are predicted to exceed 26 Degrees Celsius students may remove the blazers and vests,  
and girls may wear an open-toed black sandal (No flip-flops).**

### Notes

1. Uniforms are to be clean, tidy, with no holes and are to be worn properly. Clothes should not be tight fitting or excessively loose. No bare midriffs.
2. If cold, students may wear the fleece jacket/hoodie/Heritage vest/Heritage long sleeved polo shirt. (**Top Marks only**). **Non uniform items will not be permitted.**
3. HawksWear jackets and hoodies are available throughout the year from the Physical Education department. These items are ordered in bulk, therefore particular items and sizes may not always be available.
4. If students choose to wear another shirt under their polo shirt, that shirt must be uniform colours ONLY and **not be visible below the bottom of the polo shirt.**
5. Ties must be worn properly, snugged up to the collar at all times.
6. Oxford white dress shirts must be tucked in at all times. Lady’s fitted blouse may be worn un-tucked. **White dress shirts must be worn with a tie.**
7. Hats and bandanas are not permitted with the uniform inside the school.
8. Piercings – Boys may wear one stud in each ear. Spikes, hoops and lobe stretchers are not permitted for boys or girls. A small eyebrow ring and a small nose stud are also permitted. No other body piercing (including but not limited to: lips, tongue or any other part of the face) is permitted.
9. Visible tattoos are not permitted.
10. All uniform requirements are in effect for field trips. Field trip notices will indicate the type of uniform to wear.
11. If students are not wearing the proper uniform, they may borrow from the uniform bank for \$1/day until the piece is returned and debt paid.
12. There will be consequences for improperly worn uniforms as determined by the school administration.

**The uniform must be in good repair and worn properly at all times!**
